The Needle Exchange coordinator oversees the coordination and administration of the agency's Bathurst Needle Exchange Program. It is the role of the coordinator to ensure that clients have access to safer injection equipment for the purposes of reducing the spread of HIV, hepatitis C, and other blood borne infections, and have access to necessary services.
