OVERVIEW

The Harm Reduction Coordinator oversees the coordination and administration of the agency's Bathurst and Northern New Brunswick Harm Reduction Program. It is the role of the coordinator to ensure that clients have access to safer drug use and safer sex equipment for the purposes of reducing the spread of HIV, hepatitis C, and other sexually transmitted and blood borne infections, and have access to necessary services.

EXPERIENCE

Minimum High School diploma or significant related experience. Community College or University education in Social/Health Sciences is considered an asset. Experience in this field is considered a strong asset regardless of post-secondary education.
